Dear Principal,

We are passing through unprecedented times and the COVID-19 pandemic has disrupted the entire academic activity at the affiliated institutes. Attempts at reviving teaching and examination schedules had to be withdrawn owing to the continued increase and spread of the virus. Nevertheless, the National Council has been actively conscious to the anxiety of students regarding their future.

After due recommendations and approval of competent authority, it has been decided that examinations for short courses cannot be conducted at institutes in the conventional method, owing to restrictions. Hence, assessments for all students of short courses will be based on aggregate (theory + practical) of previous semester (70%) and mid-term performance (30%). For the five trade diploma courses, which are annual programs, mid-term marks will constitute 100%. For PG Accommodation Operations and PG Dietetics results will be processed similarly, but upon receipt of Internship marks.

For Regular/ Reappear/ Compartment and fail students of Short Courses, who's mid-term/ internal assessment marks are not available in view of being absent for any reason, institutes may send their marks by evaluating through online assignments; MCQ questionnaire; ppt method; or any other method deemed fit by the institute but retaining the base record. These marks may be made available to NCHM by 10th July 2020 ensuring submission of Examination Form with fee. For the purpose THIMS portal would be made available till such time.

Since MSc. and BSc. programs are offered in collaboration with IGNOU, recommendations of the NCHM Examination Committee have been communicated to them regarding examination and promotion methodology. Reply from IGNOU is awaited. The same would be communicated immediately on receipt and till such time institutes are requested to continue to appropriately engage and counsel their students.
